As is customary, the Southwest Regional Championship Regatta was sailed with KISS (Keystone Interclass Single-Handed Sailor), a fun regatta in which there were forty-one entries, including the MC Scows. Ten different types of boats were sailed in three classes - MCs, centerboards, and keelboats - ranging from Sunfish to Catalina 27s.

This five-race event was sailed in generally light and shifty winds with temperatures in the seventies.

Scoring provisions for the MC Scows allowed for one throwout if all five races were sailed. Also, no crew was allowed except for women entries and male skippers weighing less than one hundred and fifty pounds. But no crew was needed by anyone for wind speed was never more than 10 mph.
