## Welcome Fleet 56 Glen Lake Yacht Club, Michigan

The Glen Lake Yacht Club is located on a bluff overlooking beautiful Glen Lake In Leelanau county northwest corner of the Lower Peninsula), Michigan.

The GLYC was formed in the late 1930's with the clubhouse being constructed in 1941. Snipes were the first one-design sailboat raced at the club. Many of the boats in the fleet were hand built by their skippers and their families. In the height of the Snipe era

the fleet numbered about 15 racers. In the 1960's the Woodpussy was introduced as a boat that could be sailed single-handed or with a crew.

The 1970's brought a decline of the Snipes and Woodpussys which were rapidly replaced by the Sunfish and Laser. The GLYC has hosted many national regattas, including Snipes, Interlakes and the Buccaneer.

The MC Scow was introduced to the club by Rich Green in the 1980's and caught the eye of all. Slowly, as the Laser sailors aged, had families, and could no longer get away with a whole day on the water alone, the MC began to flourish.

Today the GLYC is IMCCSRA Fleet #56 and has 11 boats in the fleet.

Races are held on Saturday at 1:00 PM and on Sunday at 11 AM. Visitors in the area are encouraged to call Fleet Captain Dick Colbath at 616 334-4503 for any details in regard to participating in the races.

This fall, the LHYC's DieHard Regatta

will be held on Lake Calhoun on Septem-

ber 13 and 14. The City of Minneapolis is

planning some construction around Lake Harriet, so it will be closed on August 1st
