

2019 MC Nationals Regatta Launch/Haul Out Instructions

Launch – Thursday August 22, 2019; 11:00 AM – 7:00PM

Check-in will be held at Deephaven Elementary School, 4452 Vine Hill Rd Wayzata, MN 55391

- Sailors will check in and be handed a launch card
- Stickers will be placed on the tongue of the trailer. Wait until told to proceed to Staging Area
- Boats will head South on Vine Hill Road (right) out of school, take right on Cottagewood Road, stay right on Cottagewood Road, take right on Minnetonka Blvd. Follow signs. Staging area will be on the shoulder heading East on Minnetonka Blvd. MYC personnel will be waiting for you.
- Once in the Staging area, step your mast, rig boat and wait to be cleared into Carson Bay Facility (CBF) for launch. Boats will not be allowed into CBF without launch card.
- **Registration will be at the CBF facility. Please enter the CBF building and complete your registration and pick up your shirt and gift bag.**
- Once your boat is launched, proceed west on Minnetonka Blvd (right out of CBF) and go to Trailer Parking (TP) at City Hall parking lot.
- All trailers will be given a parking space number and parked for you in the hockey rink area. You will be given a trailer retrieval card with Class/Sail# and space number for use at Haul Out. Keep card on the dashboard of the tow vehicle.
- Proceed to the mooring location to meet your boat, which will be towed over from the crane by our Mooring Crew. If you arrive with a crew, or second person, they will accompany your boat as it is towed from CBF to it's mooring/dock

Haul Out– Saturday August 25, 2019; After racing concludes

The haul out order is dictated by the release of a tow vehicle from the City Hall parking lot by Trailer Parking. No tow vehicles will be allowed to go to the staging area or CBF without being released by Trailer Parking Personnel. This includes trailers parked in the hockey rink and trailers *not parked* at hockey rink. Trailer Parking Personnel will issue a haul out card to tow vehicles before they head to staging.

- Sail to CBF. (Consider dropping crew at your mooring dock to retrieve tow car and proceed to Trailer Parking) ***You should have your lifting bridle with your boat.***
- Once secured to the dock at CBF, de-rig as much as possible to expedite the haul-out process.
- The MYC crew will ferry sailors as needed back to their mooring dock to retrieve their car.
- Proceed to the Trailer Parking, Deephaven City Hall.
- Tow Vehicle arrives at Deephaven City Hall Parking lot
- Give Trailer Parking Personnel trailer card with class/sail#, parking space #
- Trailer Parking personnel will retrieve the trailer.
- Haul Out card is issued to driver of tow vehicle
- Tow vehicle is released to Staging area as space allows.

*If trailer is not parked in hockey rink, tow vehicle still needs to go through Trailer Parking personnel to be issued a Haul Out card and be released to Staging, if using the MYC crane at CBF.

- As trailers arrive in Staging, they will be released to CBF as space permits.
- Dockmaster gets boats staged in order of trailers waiting in staging area. As boats are hoisted, they will be power-washed prior to being loaded on the trailer.
- Drop rig and do a quick tie-down. Handle final tie-down and travel prep at Deephaven Elementary, where Awards will be held.

*You are certainly welcome to bypass the CBF haul out process and use area ramps (Carson's Bay, Wayzata, etc.)

This Process has been used previously for big regattas and if everyone follows instructions it will result in a smooth and efficient experience. We look forward to seeing you at MYC!
